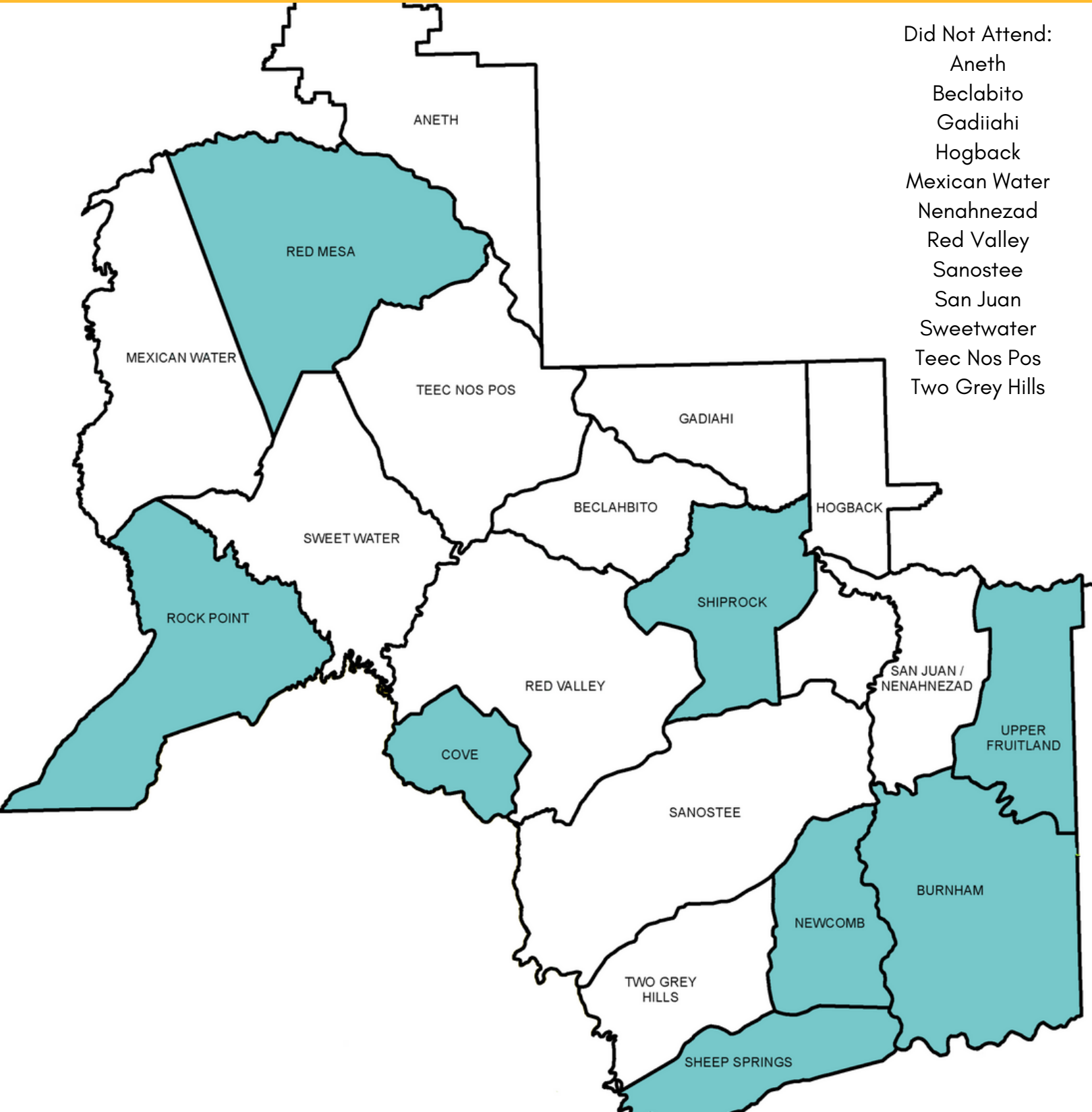

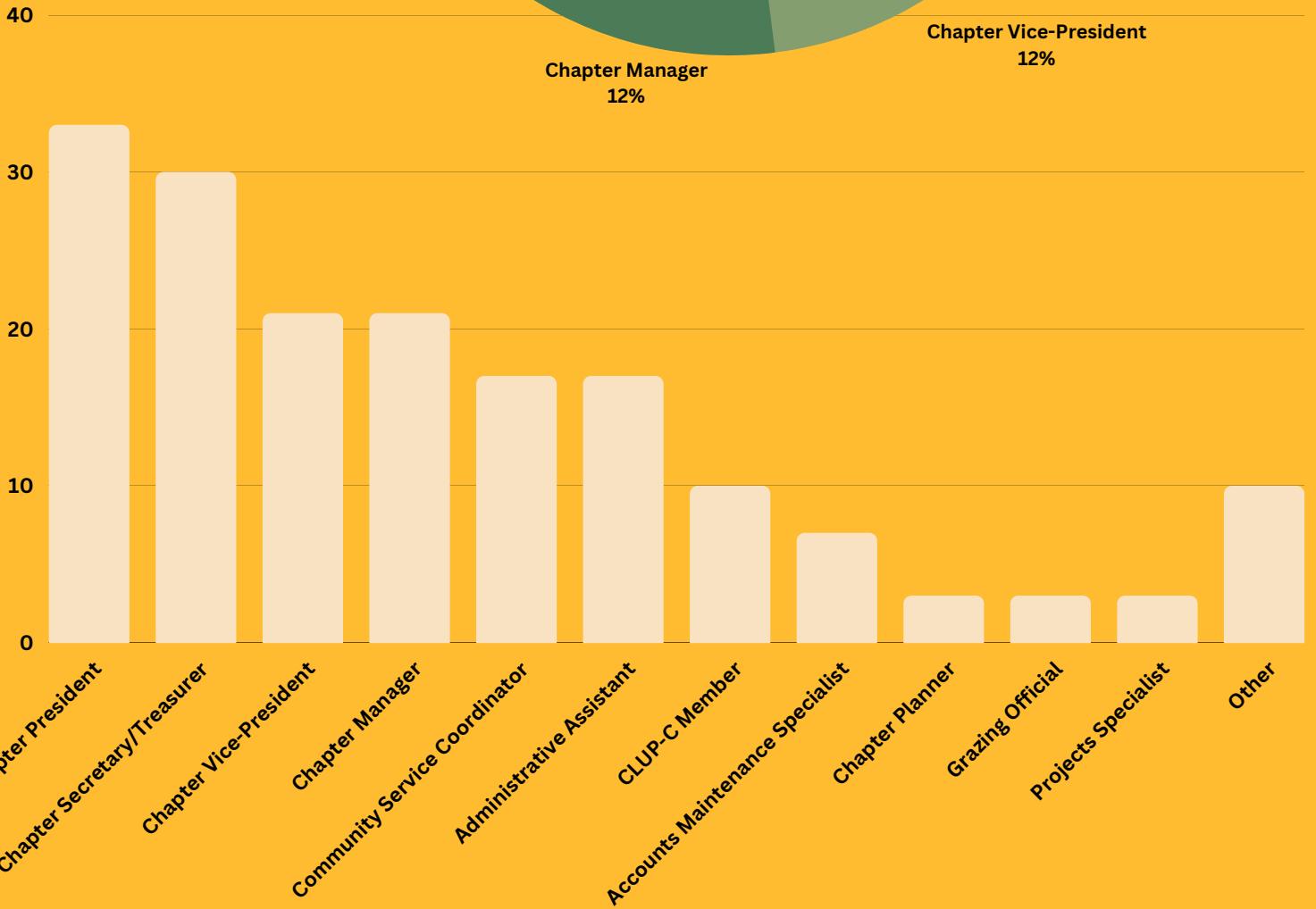

# FEEDBACK RESULTS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Main Takeaways from Feedback Survey:

- "There should be a second session" & "It would be nice to have two sessions"
- "More time for questions (+2 hours for questions)" & "Additional time to answer questions. They were very important and insightful"
- "It was worth my time as a chapter employee - specially Title 26", "The Constitutional Attempts & History [were] very educational", "Very helpful and made my view on the whole chapter process a bit clearer."

Takeaways:

Recommendations:
