- I am proposing that a full fledged budget is set aside fully endorsed by the Navajo Nation Council's Budgeting process to instituted full funding for an administrative operation cost to address the ongoing education that is necessary both in English and Navajo. - Ongoing data collection on a real-time basis and a platform built out for the chapters to take ownership of their raw information to allow funding advocacy and seeking outside funding and etc.

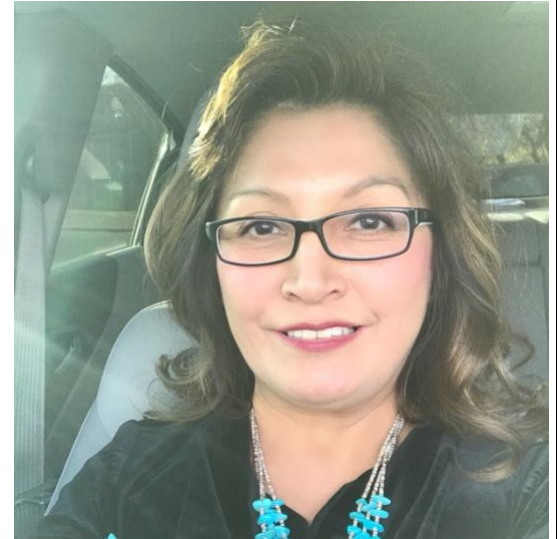
